ADULT CARERS SUPPORT PLANS AND YOUNG CARERS STATEMENTS

Under the Carers (Scotland) Act 2016, anyone who provides support to a family member, neighbour or friend has a legal right to have an Adult Carers Support Plan (ACSP) or a Young Carers Statement (YCS) completed in order to identify the needs of the carer and help them access information, advice and support, before reaching a crisis point. The ACSP/YCS can be shared with others to help them understand your needs too.

If you would like an ACSP, or need a current one reviewed, get in touch with our Adult Carers Manager, David Reid to arrange. And if you would like a YCS, get in touch with our Young Carers Development Manager, Ryan Duffy.

FINANCES

It feels like winter is fast approaching, and we know that means extra worries for carers and their families.

We are here to help access the right benefits, grants and other financial supports. Call one of our office numbers to book an appointment to maximise any benefits you may be entitled to. Last year we helped families access £4.7million in unclaimed benefits - so it's definitely worth a call!

UNPAID CARERS - SHORT BREAK FUND

We have a fund for unpaid carers to apply for money or items towards a "break" from their caring role.

Please contact our Short Breaks Co-ordinator Shannon who can help you explore the possibilities and help you relax and unwind! This fund is open to Adult and Young Carers.

HOSPITAL DISCHARGE

A reminder that we have staff members who can help with your loved ones hospital discharge. Our Hospital Discharge Carer Link Workers cover the acute and community hospitals in Ayrshire.

If you have a loved one in hospital or they are about to go into hospital, please get in touch as our staff can help with their planned discharge and make sure you have the right support for yourself as the unpaid carer.

Carers Groups

We run support groups and coffee mornings across East Ayrshire to help carers access social opportunities to reduce isolation and opportunities for peer support and friendship too.

Support groups are for unpaid carers only and we welcome outside speakers/special events.

Coffee mornings welcome unpaid carers and the people they care for and former carers too.
